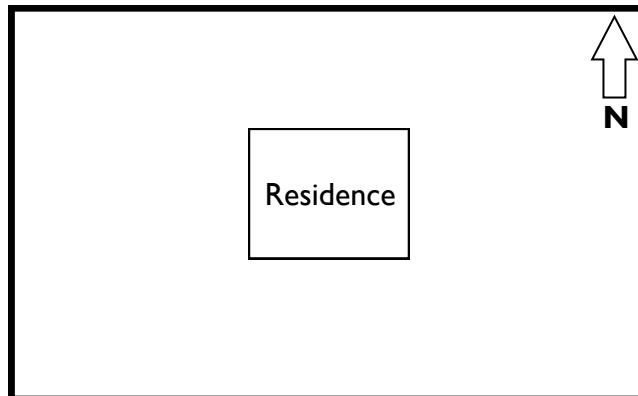

50/50 Tree Planting Program 2017-2018

Through its 50/50 Tree Program, the Village of Winfield shares the cost of planting parkway trees with homeowners on a split cost basis. All residents that have room on a public parkway are eligible to participate. Residents simply choose which tree(s) they want and send in a check for the resident contribution amount listed. The Village handles the rest. Information on available trees is included in this brochure.

Trees will be planted by a contractor in the parkway adjacent to your home. Each tree is a minimum of two inches in caliber, and comes with a watering bag as well as a one year replacement warranty from the nursery. **Participants should plan to refill the watering bag 1 to 2 times a week to ensure the tree transplants successfully.**

To be eligible for the program, trees should be planted 40 feet apart from other trees on all sides, 4 feet from any curb or sidewalk, and 30 feet from intersections. Village staff will confirm the planting location and handle all of the planting details. **Trees purchased will be planted in spring 2018.** Private property trees are ineligible for this program.

There is a limited budget for the program and orders will be accepted first come-first served until the budget is expended. Orders, with checks payable to the Village of Winfield, must be received by August 25, 2017. The price listed for each tree is the homeowners share of the tree cost. The Village offers an alternative for residents who wish to plant a different tree species than provided in the 50/50 brochure. In addition, the Village offers a cost-sharing program for homeowners associations with private parkways. Please visit the Village website or contact Village Hall for more details.

Common Hackberry (*Celtis occidentalis*)

The Hackberry is a large tree, valued for drought tolerance. Small monoecious flowers appear in the spring. Has a yellow/gold fall color. Grows at a relatively fast pace, up to 80 feet in height at full maturity. 2.5" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost : \$171



Skyline Honeylocust (*Gleditsia triacanthos inermis*)

The Thornless Honeylocust is a large tree, known for high drought, pollution, and salt tolerance, making them very adaptable to many soils. Has a yellow/green fall color. Grows at a fast pace, with a mature height of 70 feet. 2.5" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost : \$176

Yellowwood (*Cladrastis kentukea*)

The Yellowwood is a medium sized tree and performs best in dry areas. After established, white flowers bloom in spring/early summer. Has a golden fall color. Grows at a moderate pace, up to 50 feet in height at full maturity. 2"- 3" sizes available. Starting cost : \$186



Bur Oak (*Quercus macrocarpa*)

The Bur Oak is a large tree, known for drought tolerance, winter hardiness, and minimal issues with insects and diseases. Performs well in a variety of soils. Has a reddish to yellow/gold fall color. Grows at a slow pace, up to 80 feet in height at full maturity. 2" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost : \$181



Chanticleer Pear (*Pyrus calleryana*)

The Chanticleer Pear has a narrow pyramidal growing habit. Flower displays are showy, and the clean foliage is attractive throughout the summer months, presenting a slightly finer texture due to the narrowness of the leaves. Its maximum height is 30-50' high by 15-20' wide. Leaves are glossy dark green in summer, changing to a moderate purple-red in autumn. 2" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost: \$156
